

Introduction

With the goal of **minimizing industrial waste** and **reducing its environmental impact**, the Armani group has intensified its research aimed at using materials of organic origin or obtained through recycling or regeneration, as well as second-generation raw materials.

The Armani group's brands are committed to the selection of sustainable raw materials through the increasing use of organic and recycled materials.

In 2021, the group drafted those updated guidelines replacing the previous ASP (Armani sustainability project) protocol and integrating it with new protocols, standards, and sustainability certifications. In particular:

- they provide instructions for each type of material and are a reference for internal departments – from design, research and development, to manufacturing and merchandising – and for suppliers.
- they refer to "preferred materials", according to the definition of <u>Textile Exchange</u>: "A fiber or raw material that delivers consistently reduced impacts and increased benefits for climate, nature, and people against the conventional equivalent, through a holistic approach to transforming production systems."
- they take into account international standards, although the group often go beyond them.
